GENERAL INFORMATION

- Admission: \$3 adults, \$2 Students with ASB card, \$1 children (under 12).
 - All Varsity games will be played at Mission Viejo High School.
- Junior Varsity and Frosh-soph games will be played at El Toro and Mission Viejo High Schools.
 - Parking at Mission Viejo High School will be in the upper lot only.
- Parking at El Toro High School will be on the East side of the campus (Serrano Ave lot).
 - Varsity games will be 40 minute halves with a 3-man crew.
- Junior Varsity and Frosh-soph games will be 35 minute halves with a 2-man crew.
- An athletic trainer will be provided, but each team must provide their own tape.
 - Bathrooms are available at both sites.
- A limited snack bar will also be available at both sites.
 - Coaches and players will be admitted at no cost.

- All spectators, coaches and players will receive a hand stamp upon entrance. This stamp will be honored when traveling between the two sites. The stamp will also be changed each day.
